

START POSITION: Heels on marks (X X) in area A. Firearm loaded in holster. Hands on knees.






SETUP NOTES: Targets T1 & T3 and T2 & T5 are mounted above each other on one target stand. The bottom of T3, T4, are 14 inches above ground. Hard cover on T3 and T5 covers from left top where the D scoring line and C scoring join, straight down to the corner of the A zone then straight across the A zone (As shown). Area A is 0.92m (3') by 0.92m (3').




START POSITION: Standing anywhere in area A, strong hand on top of opposite shoulder. Firearm loaded in holster

STAGE PROCEDURE

On the start signal, engage targets T1- T6 as they come visible.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 12 rounds, 60 points TARGETS: 6 IPSC SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC START-STOP: Audible - Last shot PENALTIES: Procedural. - 10 No-shoot hit. -10 Miss. -10






STAGE 6 - Zig-Zag

COURSE DESIGNER: Mark Graham

START POSITION: Facing down range standing with feet on the X's, Firearm loaded in holster and all ammo will be place on barrels (shooters choice) no ammo on belt to start

Hands touching knees to indicate shooter is ready

COURSE DESIGNER: Mark Graham

START POSITION: Standing with heels on the X's arms resting at your sides. On the start signal engage targets as they come visible. Holding briefcase until deposited in storage holder near door. Any shot fired while briefcase is not in competitor's hand or in the storage holder will incur one procedural penalty per shot fired.


Firearm is unloaded and in your holster. Briefcase start position will be placed on shooter weak hand side.

STAGE PROCEDURE

On start signal, engage targets T-T9 as they become visible.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 18 rounds, 90 points TARGETS: 9 IPSC, 1 no-shoot SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC START-STOP: Audible - Stops on last shot PENALTIES: Procedural. - 10 No-shoot hit. -10 Miss. -10







STAGE 7 - Running Back



Strong hand on door knob, other arm resting at your side. Firearm loaded in holster.


STAGE PROCEDURE SCORING On the start signal, engage targets T1- T15 as they come visible. SCORING: Comstock,30 rounds,150 points TARGETS: 15 IPSC 1 no-shoot SCORED HITS: Best 2 per IPSC START-STOP: Audible - Last shot PENALTIES: Procedural. - 10 No shoot - 10 Miss. -10







SCORING: Comstock, 9 rounds, 45 points TARGETS: 9 IPSC mini, 6 no-shoots SCORED HITS: Best 1 per IPSC mini START-STOP: Audible - Last shot PENALTIES: Procedural. - 10 No-shoot hit. -10 Miss. -10


START POSITION: Standing on X's facing down range with hands above your head. Firearm unloaded and on a table and ALL ammo to be used is on the other table.

On Start signal, engage T1- T4 staying within the fault lines





Shepard Range




